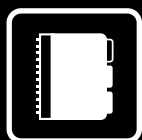

CPS Timeline

Below is a step by step overview of the CPS publishing timeline.



1. Visit www.computer.org/cps.



2. Complete the *Mandatory Publishing Requirements Form (MPR)* and the *Online Inquiry Form*.



3. Receive a *Quote* within five business days. Review, modify, and/or accept a desired variation.



4. Quality Assurance reviews MPR upon receipt of agreement.



5. An editor and eRoom are assigned. Conference publication management process begins.



6. Editor and Organizer discuss the publication process.



7. IEEE Forms are completed and submitted by the CPS editor.

8. An Online Author Kit is created for paper and copyright form submission.



9. Front matter, papers and artwork are submitted.



10. Preprint Assessment processes PDF files.



11. Front matter and artwork are reviewed, modified, and/or approved by conference organizers.



12. Timely delivery to the conference is ensured.



13. A request for no-shows is sent to the conference organizers the day after the conference ends.



14. Conference files are submitted to the CSDL and Xplore™, as well as for indexing. Files are posted within two weeks.

Taking Care of Your Conference: Experienced and Professional Editors

CPS Online™ : All You Need, Anytime You Need It

CPS Online™ is the Computer Society's online collaborative conference publishing system, which is a web-based project management tool, and provides real-time online access to the status of each project.

CPS Online™

- Speeds the delivery of publishing quotes, including up to six variations in page count, quantity and media type
- Provides the conference's "Primary Contact" person with real-time internet access to all the project's publication materials during production, including final submitted papers
- Gives conference organizers and authors the opportunity to upload files through any Web browser
- Check scheduling on a project
- Make changes to the Table of Contents and Front Matter
- Approve editorial changes and proofs

- Communicate with the CPS editor through discussion forums, chat tools, commenting tools and e-mail
- Access to “Author’s Final Paper Formatting and Submission Instructions” Webpage (Online Author Kit) for collection of accepted papers, copyright forms and metadata information
- Access to IEEE PDF eXpress™, the online source file conversion / PDF validation tool that assists in the creation of IEEE-Xplore™ compliant PDF files for final submission

Preprint Assessment

CPS has trained staff that will take care of any errors on submitted PDF files. Papers submitted through the Online Author Kit are all put through a rigorous Quality Control process so that they are both print and Xplore™ compliant.

The CSDL and Xplore™

CPS prides itself on the timely posting of conference media to the CSDL and Xplore™. Conference organizers and authors do not want to wait months for papers to appear in these digital libraries. CPS guarantees that papers will be posted to the CSDL and Xplore™ no later than 30 days after the close of the conference.

Indexing

CPS understands the importance of indexing to the long-term success of a conference. CPS arranges for indexing through INSPEC, EI (Compendex), Thomson ISI, and other indexing services.

Sweating the Details: Paperwork

CPS editors make sure all of the necessary paperwork is filed and that the conference has all of the necessary information for inclusion in the CSDL, IEEE Xplore™, and indexing.

CPS obtains:

- All required copyrights
- Library of Congress/ISSN
- ISBN and other bibliographical registration details

All of the author papers in your publication will have a Digital Object Identification Number (DOI), allowing for easy searches and protection against plagiarism.

Protecting the Integrity of a Conference: No-shows

CPS understands how important the perception of a conference is to the organizers, authors, and community in which that conference resides. This is why any conference published by CPS has the protection of the IEEE No-show policy. If a presenter does not attend a conference without legitimate reason the conference organizer has the right to pull their paper from final posting to the CSDL, Xplore™, and indexing. This gives organizers another tool to protect their conference and to make sure it never picks up the reputation as a paper mill event.

Content Delivered: Shipping

All the work that goes into creating a conference publication can be undone by one simple word: Customs. CPS recognizes the importance of staying on top of shipping and works extensively with international shipping representatives to make sure conference media is delivered on time, every time.

Looking Good on the Outside: Cover Art and CD Design

CPS has highly skilled graphic artists on staff to make sure your conference publication looks as professional as the work inside. They will work with the editor and conference organizer to give each conference a unique look for all media types. To save conferences money in these economic times, there is no additional charge for 4-color cover art.





MODES OF TRANSPORTATION

(Media Types)

CPS Currently Supports the Following Types of Media for Conference Publications

- **Books** - We can print standard US, European, and 6x9 versions of conference publications.
- **CD-ROMS** - Conference papers are presented in an eGuide format, which enables attendees to search via session, author, or keyword. eGuides and CD labels are designed by our professional graphic artists.
- **USB/Flash Drives** - These are similar to CD-ROMS and DVDs, with multiple drive styles and packaging options available.
- **Editorial-Only** - This option enables conferences to produce physical media locally by receiving an electronic copy of the manuscript.
- **Conference Programs** - CPS is now able to design your conference program for either physical or mobile application distribution.
- **Conference Program Mobile App** - Let your attendees have their conference schedule, conference information, and paper listings in the palm of their hands. CPS now offers a conference program Mobile App that works for Android devices, iPhone, iPad, and the Blackberry PlayBook.
- **WebPub** - Your conference publication will appear on a Computer Society hosted webpage, complete with user login and password protection. Sponsorship logos, all the front matter, and author papers are included on the site.

MODES OF TRANSPORTATION

(Media Types)

- **Abstract Book** - This much smaller manuscript contains only the conference front matter and abstracts for accepted author papers. This is typically chosen in conjunction with an electronic media option.
- **Books with CD/DVDs** - A book and CD-ROM with the same content.
- **Books + CD/DVDs** - A book and CD-ROM combination where each product can contain different content.
- **SD Cards** - This option allows for a much smaller physical product with the same storage capacity as a USB/Flash drive.
- **Publication Packages** - Conferences can choose any combination of the above products.

Your Conference's Reputation Helps Ensure its Success

Both the Computer Society and IEEE have specific requirements regarding such details as field of interest, peer review process, conference venue information, no-show policies, how and when logos may be displayed, and organizing committee contacts. The purpose of these requirements is to help ensure that the long-standing international reputation of IEEE publications remains strong. The criteria also protect and enhance the reputation of every conference that publishes with CPS.

CPS's Quality Assurance team has developed tools and has staff in place to help you navigate these quality assurance requirements smoothly and successfully. If your conference is eligible, we're there to support you.
